

## **Top 10 Most-Active Dancers**

**2010 - 2011**

A new, promotion, award program will run from **June 1, 2010 to May 31, 2011**. Awards will be presented at the 2011 State Convention in Rochester to the ten people who attended the most dances or dance-related events during the year. Winners will be determined by the point system detailed below.

- All ten winners must be members of the Square Dance Federation of Minnesota, Inc., which includes Federation clubs in five states (Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa, and Wisconsin).
- All events must be affiliated with the Square Dance Federation of Minnesota, Inc., either through members of the Federation or clubs or regions or the Federation. In other words, these awards will be won by the dancers who attend events in Minnesota or the clubs in four other states that are affiliated with the Square Dance Federation of Minnesota, Inc. The only exception will be the National Convention.
- Each dancer must turn in a list of the dances or events she or he attended. Each event or dance must have the signature of the caller or cuer. Each listing must answer the questions: what? when? where? followed by the signature. The dancer should tally the total points earned and put it on the top page or cover. The log book must be in the hands of the state promotion directors by June 4, 2011, so the points can be verified before the convention.

### **Points:**

- club dance (1 point each) Each dance earns one point. (If you attend 9 dances at the same club, you get 9 points.)
  - demos (1 point each)
  - parades (1 point each)
  - angel at lessons (1 point each evening)
  - camping clubs (1 point per day if that day includes dancing)
  - club, region or Federation meetings (1 point per meeting--officer must sign your book)
  - Friendship Set to Music (1 point per show -- two on a Saturday morning)
  - special weekends (2 per day if there is at least 2 hours of dancing that day)
  - State Convention (3 per day if you dance)
  - National Convention (3 per day if you dance)
  - special events/dances (1 point each)
  - ABC dances (1 point each)
  - State Fair (1 point for every two hours)
  - county fairs (1-2 points per day, depending upon hours involved)
  - special promotional dances (1 point each)
- (and yes, if round dances are separate events; use the same point values.)

The top ten dancers who attend the most dances will earn the title of Number 1 Most-Active Dancer in 2010-2011, Number 2 Most-Active Dancer in 2010-2011, Number 3 Most-Active Dancer in 2010-2011, etc. The promotion directors will make the final decision on any disputed points. Find a little book that you can carry with you to all dances and events for twelve months. Get the required signature at each dance. Good luck!
